General Business: Calendar of Events
Draft Calendar attached. Associations and clubs are asked to prepare their own calendars so clashes are avoided.

Junior Masters Circuit (10/, 12/U, 14/U, 16/U)

Lead-in events will be sanctioned for Sale in October, Bairnsdale in November, Maffra in December, and Lakes Entrance in February.

The Region will take entries and prepare draws as in the past, however, the Region will no longer conduct the events for the host clubs. Clubs themselves are required to conduct Lead-in events.

Where a nominated club does not wish to conduct their Lead-in TEG must be advised 30 days' prior to the event and the remaining clubs may nominate their venue and the event will be allocated by random selection.

¹ where a nominated club does not advise TEG within 30 days it forfeits its corresponding Lead-in in 2012/13

Entry fees will be \$8 per player (up just \$1 on fee first introduced in 2004) with \$2 being per player being remitted to TEG.

The Lead-in events will be followed by the Masters Finals in Bairnsdale in March/April.

2012 Inter-Regional Championships at Wangaratta

TEG was awarded the “Most Improved Region” at the 2011 IR Championships despite not fielding a full team.

The Regional Council is *determined* to field a full team for Wangaratta in junior, senior and veteran divisions.
